We express our concern about the soaring criminalization of human rights defenders (HRD) in the Philippines and demand that you take immediate and effective measures against the criminalization of HRD.

We remind you of legal duties and responsibilities that stem from international covenants and declarations, especially International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and the United Nations Declaration on Human Rights Defenders:
